## CT Acquired Brain Injury

The ABI program provides various non-medical services to individuals with an acquired brain injury who meet the Department of Social Services' criteria for program eligibility. The program allows individuals to live outside of institutions and nursing facilities by allowing for services to be provided in their home and community settings.

As the assigned Financial Intermediary, Allied Community Resources is responsible for but not limited to:



- Providing in-home enrollment, training and information to program participant who choose to selfdirect their services as a household employer.
- Employment verification/documentation for household employers' employees.
- Payroll and reimbursements for household employers' employees.
