CT Department of Developmental Services

The DDS program is responsible for the planning, development and administration of services to persons with intellectual disabilities and individuals medically diagnosed as having Prader-Willi Syndrome. Services include the residential placement and in-home supports, day and employment programs, early intervention, family support, respite, case management and other services.

As the assigned Financial Intermediary, Allied Community Resources is responsible for but not limited to:



- Providing in-home enrollment, training and information to program participant who choose to self-direct their services as a household employer.
- Employment verification/documentation for household employers' employees.
- Payroll and reimbursements for household employers' employees.
